Up to the 15<sup>th</sup> of March, French and Foreign students, Phd candidates, graduates and executives can submit their application for Training-Research scholarships (upload the application form on [www.fondationpalladio.fr](http://www.fondationpalladio.fr), section “ Bourse/Prix”).

Application conditions, requirements and terms of selection are specified in the sub category “Charte des Bourses”, which can also be uploaded on the website.
